

Muyu Camp is located on the banks of the Zambezi River in one of the wildest and most remote parts of Africa in the Dande Conservancy in north eastern Zimbabwe. Muyu Camp is an exclusive use photographic safari lodge for up to 12 guests in 6 rooms with commanding views over the Zambezi river framed by game rich islands.

Wake to the early morning light, the birdsong and the resident Fish Eagle calling . At the end of the day take in the beautiful sunsets and the lingering orange glow on the river and drift off to sleep to the grunt of the hippos and call of the resident Pels Fishing Owls.

Days are spent fishing, cruising down the Zambezi River, bird watching and spotting hippos and crocs whilst sipping on an ice cold beer or G&T or stopping off on a sandy river bank for brunch or sundowner drinks and snacks.

With 7km of exclusive river banks and the whole of the Zambezi River to explore, Muyu Camp offers one of the great wilderness experiences of Zimbabwe. It's a place to restore and recharge the soul and connect with family and friends.



MUYU CAMP INFORMATION

Muyu Camp consists of:

- 6 ensuite rooms with a private bathroom and a veranda that overlooks the river. Rooms have large canvas windows, overhead fans and charging
- All rooms are furnished to a very high standard with top quality linen, beds and towels.
- The lodge has an open plan lounge and dining area and a swimming pool.
- All meals are provided by Peter, the resident chef who prepares delicious home style meals for brunch and dinner. Fresh bread is baked daily.
- · Daily activities consist of river cruises and guided walks to see the abundant bird life and game. A fishing boat, rods and bait is also available.
- Wi-Fi is available in the office
- An on site Gym is available.
- · Elephant, buffalo, waterbuck, hippo and crocs are prolific in the area with the elephant and buffalo frequently crossing the river to graze on islands in front of the camp.

















NEED TO KNOW...

- . The lodge is off the grid and is fully solar-powered.
- There is a water filtration system.
- Refrigeration and an ice machine ensure that the drinks are always cold.
- The lodge is unfenced and in the dry season Elephant and Buffalo frequently pass by on route to the river with frequent crossing to the islands.
- · Muyu is a bird watchers paradise with exotic sightings including Taita Falcon, African Pitta, Green Malcoa, Pels Fishing Owl & Bat Hawk.

Muyu Camp offers an authentic wilderness experience in a remote and unspoilt part of Africa.

HOW TO GET TO MUYU

DRIVE – The camp is about 350km from Harare (about 6 hrs) routing Mazowe, Mvurwi, Guruve, Mahuwe, Mashumbi Pools, Angwa, Chapoto. The tar ends at Mahuwe and is a rough dirt road from there to camp (about 140kms). 4x4 is not essential, but a sturdy SUV or twin-cab is recommended.

FLY – This is easiest and most convenient way to get to Muyu and we can provide you with a few charter companies to check out flight rates, which will depend on the size of your party. As a guideline:

- 6 pax \$550 each return
- 12 pax **\$500 each** return
